Operating a Sports Camp

- PLAY 3 4 SPORTS OR GAMES that will be great fun and are easy to play during 20 to 30 minute segments.
- CHOOSE 3 5 SPORTS LEADERS PRAY FOR EACH GROUP who will pray for each group for protection and salvation and will be able to share a short 1 - 2 minute <u>salvation testimony</u>.
- AGE-BASED TEAMS of 10-20 that will rotate from station to station with their leaders.
- **REGISTRATION** Have all workers and students register with "stick-on" name tags. Gather contact information: name, number, and address.
- REFRESHMENTS & WATER STATIONS Refreshments must be simple, quick and able to be carried to the next event because kids will want to be involved in their next sport or game. Keep all attendees hydrated w/ water.
- EVANGELISTIC BIBLE STUDY ROTATION. It should be in a comfortable and undisturbed location. Have helpers and decision packets available.

Personal Spiritual Preparation Sheet For Workers

Personal Spiritual Preparation is essential to your usefulness.

- It is very difficult to be useful with unconfessed sin in our life (Prov. 28:13, 1 John 1:8, 9)
- Jesus called the disciples to first be with Him then preach and minister (Mark 3:14, 15);
- Jesus calls us to first be in Him and He in us if we are to be fruitful. (John 15:5)
- 1. Ernest **Prayer** is the most important necessity of individual (and team) preparation. Start praying daily as soon as you learn of the possibility of your helping in a sports camp, VBS, Bible Club, or mission trip, and don't stop praying!
- 2. Personal devotional **Bible Study** is essential to "abiding in Jesus" which is essential to being useful. Listed are just a few good recommended examples of Scriptures helpful for your personal daily Bible Study:

John 3:16-18 tells us <u>WHY</u> to do a Block Party, Sports Camp, VBS, Bible Club, or Mission Trip.

The following verses tell us <u>WHO</u> the Message is – Jesus Christ: 1:8, John 14:6, Acts 17:2-3, Acts 4:10-12

3. The following verses tell us HOW to prepare

John 1:8-9 (confess our sins)

Thessalonians 5:17 & John 14:13 (pray until we have no will of our own) Philippians 3:10,

- 4. Matthew 28:18-20 tells us <u>WHAT THE GOAL</u> is. Ephesians 6:10-18 tells us <u>WHO THE ENEMY</u> is (Keep your spiritual guard up).
- 5. Personal **Bible preparation** is essential to being a well-equipped and useful worker 2 *Timothy 2:15; 2 Timothy 3:15-17* Have marked in your Bible and know by memory some **salvation scriptures**.

<u>Some good examples are</u>: *John 3:16-18, Romans 3:23, Romans 5:8, Romans 6:23, John 14:6, Ephesians 2:8-9, Romans 10:9-10, Romans 10:13, John 1:12, Acts 3:19.*

Also, mark in your Bible some good discipleship scriptures. Some good examples are: Proverbs 28:13, 1 John 1:8-9, 2 Corinthians 5:15 & 17, John 10:27-29, Romans 8:38-39, 2 Timothy 2:15, 1 Thessalonians 5:17, John 14:13-15, Acts 1:8, Matthew 28:18-20, Philippians 4:13, Philippians 3:10, Galatians 5:22, Hebrews 10:25, John 15:5, etc.

As you prepare for your mission trip, please remember that the person best equipped to minister in a cross-cultural setting is the person who is spiritually prepared. No matter what task you will be undertaking, a servant's attitude is the most important asset you can have. The Christ-like attitude will help you to minister and be ministered. It will also help you to be flexible as you face cultural challenges and language barriers. During your mission trip, we challenge you to strive to be an encouragement and a testimony to your fellow team members as well as the missionaries and nationals with whom you will come into contact. To further ensure a successful trip that will (1) maintain a God-honoring standard for the team and OCSBA, (2) portray a proper testimony to all people impacted by the team, and (3) have a vital impact on each team member and your sending church, we have established the following guidelines:

- Exhibit a servant attitude.
- Pray for other team members and others participating in the mission project(s).
- Participate fully in all team preparation and evaluation activities.
- Practice punctuality.
- Offer grace to my fellow team members, especially to the team leader(s).
- Be flexible and fluid in every circumstance (hot, cold, rain, travel, delays, lay-overs, etc.)
- Fully submit to team leadership and the guidance of on-site nationals.
- Be a team player, encourager, and supporter.
- Accomplish whatever tasks assigned whether on the project site(s), at housing and accommodations, or while traveling as "unto the Lord."
- Be willing to abstain from conduct, as requested by team leaders, which might be
 offensive to others or may be contrary to a clear testimony for Jesus Christ, realizing
 that customs vary greatly from culture to culture. In particular, team members are asked
 to refrain from all use of tobacco, alcoholic beverages (this includes wine and beer), or
 abusive drugs.
